The prize is endowed with 35,000 euros.

The award **honors** three current scientific research projects that contribute to shaping our economic and social order. Submissions from all disciplines are welcome.

Dissertations and postdoctoral theses in German or English are **accepted**. The age limit is 40 years. Parental leave is recognized. Cumulative contributions are included.

The application deadline is December 31, 2024.
