Explaining complicated relationships clearly and breaking them down to the level of the audience is a major challenge for scientists. The language must be appropriate for the target group. Images and analogies should be chosen to illustrate the connections. Nevertheless, the explanations must meet scientific standards. A solid preparation and a good feeling for the addressees are essential. This workshop provides general background on text and language comprehensibility and on the development of explanatory approaches. Using their own research work as an example, participants practice presenting complicated content in a comprehensible way and finding and inventing suitable comparisons and images.

A large part of becoming pressure proof is learning how to deal with rejection and rigorous academic standards while performing at the highest possible level. In this workshop, participants explore the different ways of dealing with pressure and stress; learn practical skills for coping, focus and productivity and others.
