

Online Kick-Off Seminar - Moodle Login

1. TUMOnline account: TUM Lecturers, students and staff have a TUMOnline account/TUM-ID. If you're a TUM member, choose the link "I have a TUM ID". Afterwards, enter your TUM identification (e.g. "ka21bab") or your TUM-mail-address (e.g. "max.mustermann@tum.de" or "max.mustermann@mytum.de") with the corresponding password and click on the button "Login".

External participants can get a TUMOnline guest account for using the moodle course in the extended version including activities such as Wiki, Forum, online task description, Mail, etc. Ask the person at your chair or department who is in charge of TUMOnline to create a TUMOnline guest account for you.

Choose "Selbsteinschreibung/Self-enrolment" and enter the enrolment key given in the corresponding email.

2. LMU account: As a LMU member, please choose the link "I have a LMU ID" and fill in your complete CampusLMU-mail-address of the domains @lmu.de, @campus.lmu.de and @med.lmu.de and the corresponding password. Finally, click on the button "Login".

Choose "Selbsteinschreibung/Self-enrolment" and enter the password given in the corresponding email.

3. Anonymous guest: If you cannot get a TUMOnline guest account, you can log in as an anonymous guest without identification. Please click on the link "I'm a guest (no ID)" and then on the link "Log in as a guest". In this case, you don't need any access data. An **anonymous guest account** allows access to the course data. Activities such as Wiki, Forum and online task delivery are not available with such an account. Password for anonymous guests: onlinekickoff
