In this seminar, we use a range of interactive activities and feedback to develop your rhetorical skills and presentation competence for international conferences. Here we will look at areas such as body language, voice, structure, and poster layout and design. The training will provide you with a framework for developing your own talks and applying rhetorical techniques to create clearer messages.
