Stress Release for the Scientific Minded

In this workshop, you will learn quick and effective strategies to help deal with stress and anxiety, increase concentration and even help you to deepen your voice and increase confidence! Those techniques can be used 'on the fly', like before giving a presentation or even before your defense talk. The workshop will also incorporate theoretical reviews discussing evidence of the effects of breathing exercises and mediation on cognition and the brain. In the practical part, you will learn distinct kinds of relaxation methods based on mastering (1) breath, (2) posture, and (3) meditation. By the end of the course, you would own a toolbox of diverse techniques, find out which ones work best for you, and gain confidence in you own ability to cope with stressful situations hence reducing internal stress.
