The entry routes are unclear, the (often unwritten) rules of the game can seem mysterious and many don't have sufficient knowledge of German. This workshop encourages participants to prepare for this transition in a focused way and to create an action plan. Participants will reflect on what they can do and what they want to do, develop their own profile, identify their competencies and learn about networking. They will also be empowered by case-studies of numerous international doctorate holders who have successfully entered the labour market.

With the clear structure of the Scrum process, projects can be quickly and efficiently restructured and/or realigned to changing requirements of the context. Agile project methods are particularly used in technology-based developments and innovative projects, where not all requirements and parameters are known in the initial phase. Scrum offers the opportunity to achieve promising project results on the basis of structured processes.
