"Know your Trainer"

Dr. Carsten Rohr

What inspired you to pursue a career as a trainer? Was there a specific moment or influence?

I can't stand inefficiency. During my doctorate, I kept explaining optimization ideas to colleagues and students. At some point, I realized I was basically running mini-trainings, and that later became the foundation for my first real courses. During one of the many skills courses that I was attending myself, a trainer approached me if I wanted to assist him. I said yes, and from then on, I just went further down that path.

Why do you think it is important for doctoral candidates to enhance their transferable skills?



For me, transferable skills added extra perspective to my doctorate — beyond just the technical side. They shaped how I tackled problems, interacted with others and navigated processes. Good trainers challenged my thinking, broke my bubble, and surprised me. These skills weren't just for research; they helped in job hunting, setting boundaries, and life in general. Plus, I liked some of the quirky, fascinating personalities of the trainers, which made the whole experience even richer.

What do you find most rewarding about being a trainer?

Watching people have those 'aha' moments when something finally clicks when a concept changes to a real-life solution. The best sessions aren't just about me lecturing — they're about bouncing ideas around, challenging assumptions, and figuring out what actually works in the real world. It's not about sticking to a polished script; it's about digging into the messy, practical stuff that matters. And yeah, I won't lie — one of the best perks of the job is getting to throw in some unsolicited advice.
